**South Dakota Salutes** (SDS) is statewide entity of volunteers formed to show appreciation to those “First Responders” who are always there to serve and protect the citizens of South Dakota 24/7.

Plans are underway to hold our **4th Annual South Dakota Salutes** two-day appreciation shooting event on Monday and Tuesday, September 23-24, 2019 at *Hunters Pointe Shooting Complex* (HPSC) in Humboldt, SD.

Events planned each day include two (2) sporting clays tournaments, three (3) rifle tournaments & three (3) pistol tournaments. As a way to show appreciation to those who serve and protect us, the events are “FREE of Charge” to all South Dakota “First Responders” including the following groups:

- a. **Law Enforcement** – Including: city & town police; county sheriffs & deputy sheriffs; highway patrol officers; Game, Fish & Parks Officers; DCI & etc.
- b. **Fire & Rescue including EMT’s** (full-time & volunteer)
- c. **Military personnel** – including: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Reserve Units, Guard Units (active duty & retired)

Funded through Statewide Sponsorships, participants are provided with: targets; ammunition; trophies; gifts; food & beverages; and “bragging rights.”

In addition to our signature appreciation shooting competition event, cash gifts from our sponsors have allowed us to establish a special trust fund with the *Sioux Falls Area Community Foundation*. Four times in the last 18 months, we have responded with \$10,000 cash gifts to bridge the immediate financial concerns for each of the families of South Dakota First Responders who have died in the line of duty, while serving and protecting our state’s citizens.

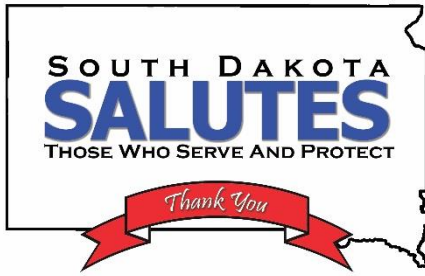
